Felsted Aid for Deprived Children has been taking aid to those in need in Eastern Europe for many years. Although the organisation started with the Kosovo area, for the last 16 years it has been delivering much needed aid for the 1st and 2nd generation survivors of the explosion at the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Station.

Alan Hilliar and Pauline Craven have established a long term friendship with Dr Vasil Pasichnik, (known as Dr. P) Director of the Revival Centre in Chernigiv, and this has improved the life quality and achievements of many thousands of children in the Ukraine.

The project is to replace the failing fleet of vans used by Felsted Aid to ship aid to the Revival Centre in the Ukraine.

The vans will carry the Rotary Wheel across Europe four times a year making it clear that the Rotary Clubs in London are the sponsors.
